3. Impact & Outcomes

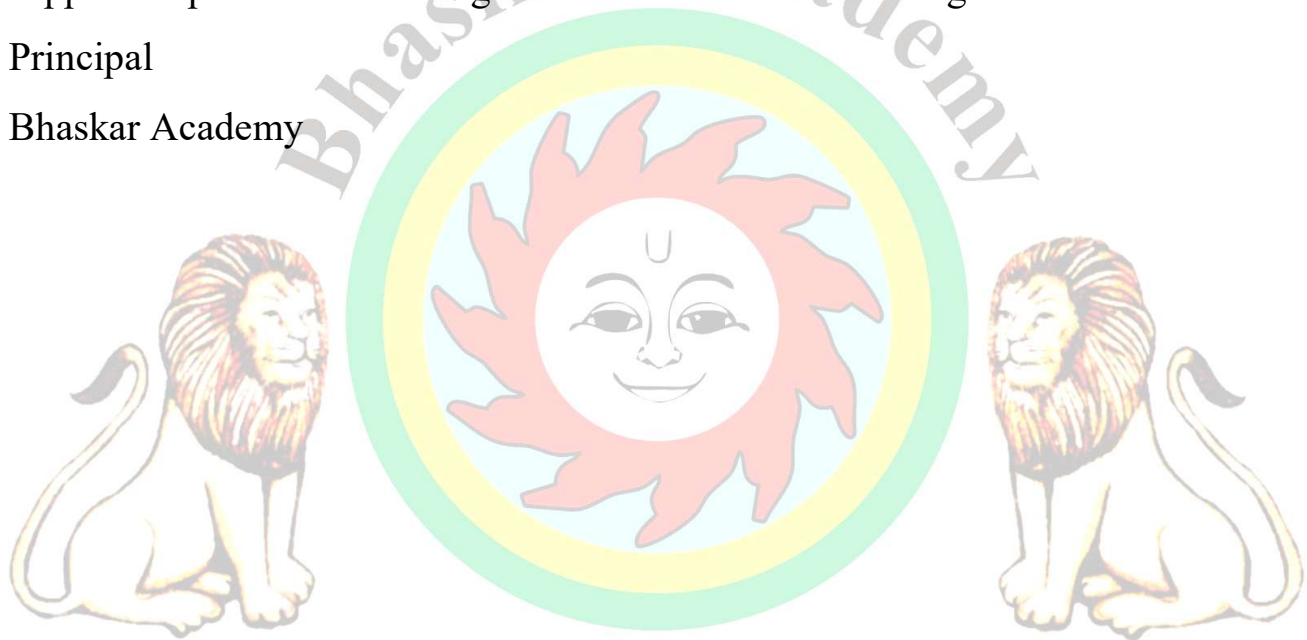
